## Recommended Patients for Care Management

Ambetter from Coordinated Care patients who may find these services most helpful include those experiencing any of the following:

- ✓ Chronic or complex health conditions such as diabetes, congestive heart failure, COPD, asthma, sickle cell disease, and depression (or other mental health illnesses).
- ✓ 3 or more hospital stays in 6 months or 3 or more ER visits in 3 months.
- ✓ Multiple health issues or recent worsening of existing conditions.
- ✓ Significant psychosocial issues or unmet needs.
- ✓ Transplant candidate or post-transplant (within 6 months).
- ✓ High-risk pregnancy or postpartum complications.
- ✓ New or unstable condition requiring life-sustaining device.
