#### **Telehealth**

Ambetter from MHS members have virtual 24/7 access to healthcare professionals to assist with their care on when and where they need it.

Member can access care via phone or video for non-emergency health issues. This allows members to request prescriptions or ask for medical advice 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

The 24/7 nurse advice line makes it easy for members to get answers to health questions any time. A registered nurse can assist members with their health or medications, or whether they should go to the emergency room, urgent care clinic, or can wait to see their regular provider.



#### **Closing Care Gaps**

Ambetter from MHS worked to help members close various care gaps to ensure members were receiving the proper care throughout the year.

Targeted communications were sent out to members to share information on services available for various health conditions. These include:

Start Smart for Your Baby® (SSFB) is an evidenced-based maternity program that identifies and engages members to improve pregnancy and birth outcomes.

SSFB connects expecting mothers with care managers to engage and empower members in accessing care and programs such as:

- Medical and behavioral healthcare
- Wellness programs
- Medical equipment
- Educational resources

Every member enrolled in SSFB receives clinically informed health education materials promoting prenatal care, postpartum care, newborn care, and healthy lifestyle habits.



#### My Health Pays® Rewards Program

Ambetter from MHS will reward members' healthy choices through our My Health Pays® Rewards Program. Members can earn dollar rewards by staying up-to-date on preventive care. These rewards will be added to a rewards card that can be used to pay for everyday items at Walmart\*, utilities, transportation, telecommunications (cell phone bill), childcare services, education and rent.
